The Plaza Theatre relies heavily on Volunteers to help carry out its mission. With only a limited staff, much of what needs to happen to make a live event or a movie showing successful can't be done without your help!

Volunteers are the backbone of most performing arts centers around the country. Volunteers serve in a variety of positions - everything from driving a nationally known artist to the airport to stuffing envelopes and helping with bulk mailings. A Volunteer is someone who cares about the Plaza and wants to help us make it a success. A Volunteer is a dependable, friendly, outgoing person with a positive attitude and a strong work ethic. A Volunteer may be YOU!

The skills a Volunteer needs are pretty basic, with the exception of a few types of Volunteers. Stage crew Volunteers and Box Office and Concession Volunteers need some specialized skills (which the Plaza staff will be happy to train you with). But the basic skills all Volunteers need are: patience, dependability, commitment, thoroughness, friendliness, and a deep care for the Plaza and our community. We can teach you which button to push or where the Diet Cokes are stored. We can't teach you to be the other things.

But please keep in mind that we need all of the Volunteer positions filled for each show. We can't start duplicating positions until all the required ones are filled.
